CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Events are open to amateurs, who are financial members of a South Gippsland Club affiliated with SGG Inc.
- The competition shall be played in accordance with the R & A Club of St. Andrews Rules of Golf, in addition to local rules that are in force at the host club.
- The Match committee encourages all players to commit to a positive pace of play objective. This will enhance everyone's experience of the day.
- If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the SGG Inc. Match Committee whose decision shall be final.
- Handicaps for grade divisions to be based on the players' Daily Handicap at the course being played, not their GA handicap
- In the event of a tie in Event 1, a play-off will be held over three holes selected by the host club, then, if necessary, by sudden death play-off.
- No post entries will be accepted in the scratch events.
- Players are permitted to use devices that measure or gauge distance only (note Rule 14-3). The use of a distance measuring device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect a players play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) is not permitted regardless of whether such an additional function is used.
- Players must report to the starter at least **30 minutes** prior to starting time.
- SGG Inc. match committee may alter the Conditions of Play should they consider it necessary.
- If the **forecast temperature** for Wonthaggi is 35 degrees or above, the Match Committee shall decide if the event will proceed.
