

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

WOMEN'S ALL GIPPSLAND SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIPS

1 All events are open to Amateurs only, who are members of Affiliated Clubs of Gippsland District Associations, and who are either:-

a: Bona-fide residents, that have been domiciled in the Gippsland District for 3 months prior to the date of the event OR

b: who if living outside the Gippsland Association's District hold full membership of a Gippsland Affiliated Club **ONLY**. Membership of a Metropolitan Club or any other club outside the Gippsland area will render a player in this category ineligible to enter the ladies Gippsland Championships. (Note: G.V defines "Country Area" as 48kms and over from the Melbourne G.P.O)

2: Post entries **WILL BE** accepted for the Championships, but players will be ineligible to win scratch events.

3: The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancients Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules as are in force at the course on which the competition takes place.

4: The Host Club shall manage the Championship. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the Standing Committee shall be consulted.

5: The Match Committee of the Host Club shall deal with any dispute or protest that may arise, and whose decision shall be final, provided that, should the Match Committee be in doubt, it shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Council of G.A whose decision will be final.

6: The Women's All Gippsland Singles Championship shall be an 18 hole event, G.A handicaps only will be used and each player must be able to produce her current Golf Link card if required.

7: In the event of a tie in Event 1 it will be decided over a 3 hole playoff and then sudden death. Ties in Event 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be decided by standard count back procedure.

9: The Match Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries. In the event of an over capacity field, preference will be given to competitors who have entered in the Women's Gippsland Singles Championships on the following day.

10. Mobile phones are permitted to allow calls from the course to the clubhouse for rules or emergency assistance only, otherwise they must be switched off.
