CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Event: 1 18 Holes Scratch Foursomes Championship
2 18 Holes Bronze Scratch Foursomes Championship - combined handicaps 46 and over
(see footnote # below)
3 18 Holes Foursomes Handicap A Grade - combined handicaps scratch to 45
(see footnote # below)
4 18 Holes Foursomes Handicap B Grade - combined handicaps 46 and over

Handicaps for grade divisions to be based on the players' Daily Handicap at the course being played, not their GA handicap. Divisions may vary slightly from the above, depending on entries.

HANDICAP'S WILL BE CAPPED AT 45 FOR PLAYERS 46-54

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a. Events are open to amateurs, who are financial members of the same South Gippsland Club affiliated with SGGI.
- b. The competition shall be played in accordance with the R & A Club of St. Andrews Rules of Golf, in addition to local rules that are in force at the host club. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the SGGI Women's Match Committee whose decision shall be final.
- c. The Foursomes Championship shall be an 18 hole event.
- d. One eligible substitute in a pair will be accepted in scratch events.
- e. Players are eligible to win both the scratch and handicap event.
- f. Each player must be able to produce her current Golf Link card or number if required.
- g. In the event of a tie in Event 1, the play-off will be over 3 holes selected by the host club, then, if necessary, by sudden death play-off. Ties in Event 2, 3 and 4 will be decided by standard countback procedures.
- h. The SGGI Women's Match Committee requests that neat, appropriate golf attire be worn.
- i. Players are permitted to use devices that measure or gauge distance only. The use of a distance measuring device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect a players play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) is not permitted regardless of whether such an additional function is used.
- j. Players must report to the starter at least 30 minutes prior to starting time.
- k. SGGI Women's Match Committee may alter the Conditions of Play should they consider it necessary.
- l. Handicaps will be capped at 45 for players 46-54.
- m. Handicaps for grade divisions to be based on the players' Daily Handicap at the course being played, not their GA handicap. Divisions may vary slightly depending on the number of entries.
- n. If the forecast temperature for Wonthaggi is 35 degrees or above, the SGGI Women's Match Committee shall decide if the event will proceed.
