Gwen has had a long lasting commitment to the South Gippsland Women's Golf Association. After commencing to play golf in the early 1980's she stepped up on to the SGLGA Committee in the early 1990's. She took on the very busy job of Secretary/Treasurer for the next six years from 1992 until 1997 and then Match Committee in 1998 & 99, Vice President in 2000 and President in 2001. That's ten years of consecutive Committee involvement and responsibility.

During this time Gwen was renowned for her efficiency and thorough approach to the positions that she held. Her meeting minutes and financial statements were meticulously kept and she had a terrific memory for recounting events and discussions. Gwen was a dedicated and co-operative volunteer with her respective committees. Gwen also greatly enjoyed her golf and was a regular participant in district golf events and encouraged others to be involved.

Whilst performing her responsibilities with the SGLGA Gwen was, at various times, the women's Captain, President and Club Champion at her own club, Korumburra, where she encouraged fellow members to support the district events.
