## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Event 2	A Grade: Individual Stableford

N.B. Grade divisions decided at close of entries. Handicaps for grade divisions to be based on the players' Daily Handicap at the course being played, not their GA handicap.

#### CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- a. Events are open to amateurs, who are financial members of the same South Gippsland Club affiliated with SGGI.
- b. The competition shall be played in accordance with the R & A Club of St. Andrews Rules of Golf, in addition to local rules that are in force at the host club. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the SGGI Match Committee whose decision shall be final.
- c. The Bowl shall be an 18 hole Stableford teams event. Each member plays individual stableford. The team with the highest aggregate stableford score shall hold the Bowl for one year.
- d. Each team to consist of 3 players, substitute players accepted, no interchange between teams.
- e. Each player must be able to produce her current Golf Link card or number if required.
- f. In the event of a tie, normal countback procedures apply on an aggregate of the last 9 holes of each player in the team. (See Guidelines for Host Clubs)
- g. The SGGI Match Committee requests that neat, appropriate golf attire be worn.
- h. Players are permitted to use devices that measure or gauge distance only.
- i. Players must report to the starter at least 30 minutes prior to starting time
- j. If the **forecast temperature (using the Willy Weather Website/App)** at 6pm. the night before is 35 degrees or above, the Match Committee shall decide if the event will proceed. If the daily temperature is 35 degrees or above at the Host Club, then play shall be abandoned.
- k. Players are eligible to win both the Bowl and the handicap event.
- l. The SGGI Match committee may alter the Conditions of Play should they consider it necessary.
- m. Handicaps capped at 45 for players 46-54.
- n. The Host Club may use electronic scoring, with cards made available for those without access to the system.
- o. The Match Committee encourages all players to commit to a positive pace of play objective. This will enhance everyone's experience of the day. Please follow the guidelines as set out by the Match committee.
