Events

1. **Mary Broadbent Bowl** - Teams Aggregate Stableford over 18 holes
Teams consist of three players with all scores to count. The team with the highest total number of points will hold the Bowl for one year. If an entered player is unable to compete on the day, another player may be substituted.
2. **18 Holes Stableford – handicap A grade.**
3. **18 Holes Stableford – handicap B grade.**
4. **18 Holes Stableford – handicap C grade.**

Conditions of play

- All events are open to amateurs only who are financial members of the same golf club.
- Handicaps for Grade Divisions will be determined according to entries received.
- Golf Australia (GA) handicaps are to be used.
- Each player must be able to produce her current Golf Link card or number, if required.
- The PIGC Ladies Committee requests that neat, appropriate golf attire be worn.
- In the event of ties, the winners will be decided on a count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.
- The competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf, together with such local rules as are in force on the course.
- Players are permitted to use devices that measure or gauge distance only (note Rule 14-3). The use of a distance measuring device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect play e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc. is not permitted regardless of whether such an additional function is available.
- Players must report to the starter at least 30 minutes before starting time.
- PIGC Ladies Match Committee may alter the Conditions of Play should they consider it necessary.

Entry fee: \$75.00 per team (\$25 per person - \$10 golf and \$15 lunch).
